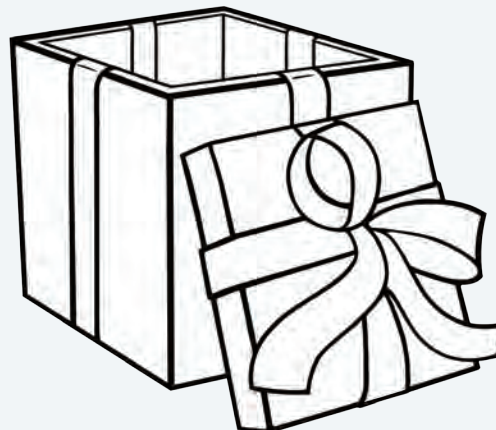
Don't Change God's Word

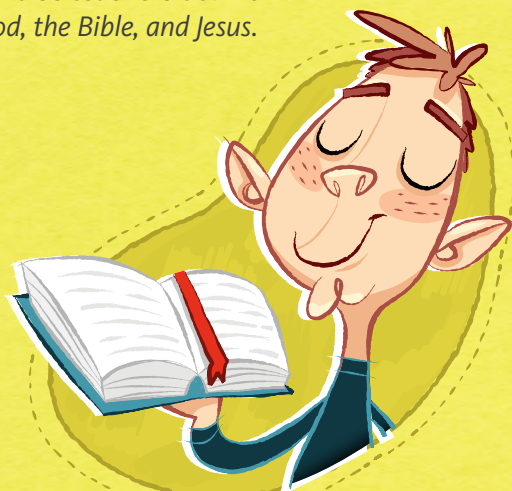


What You Heard *In the Word*

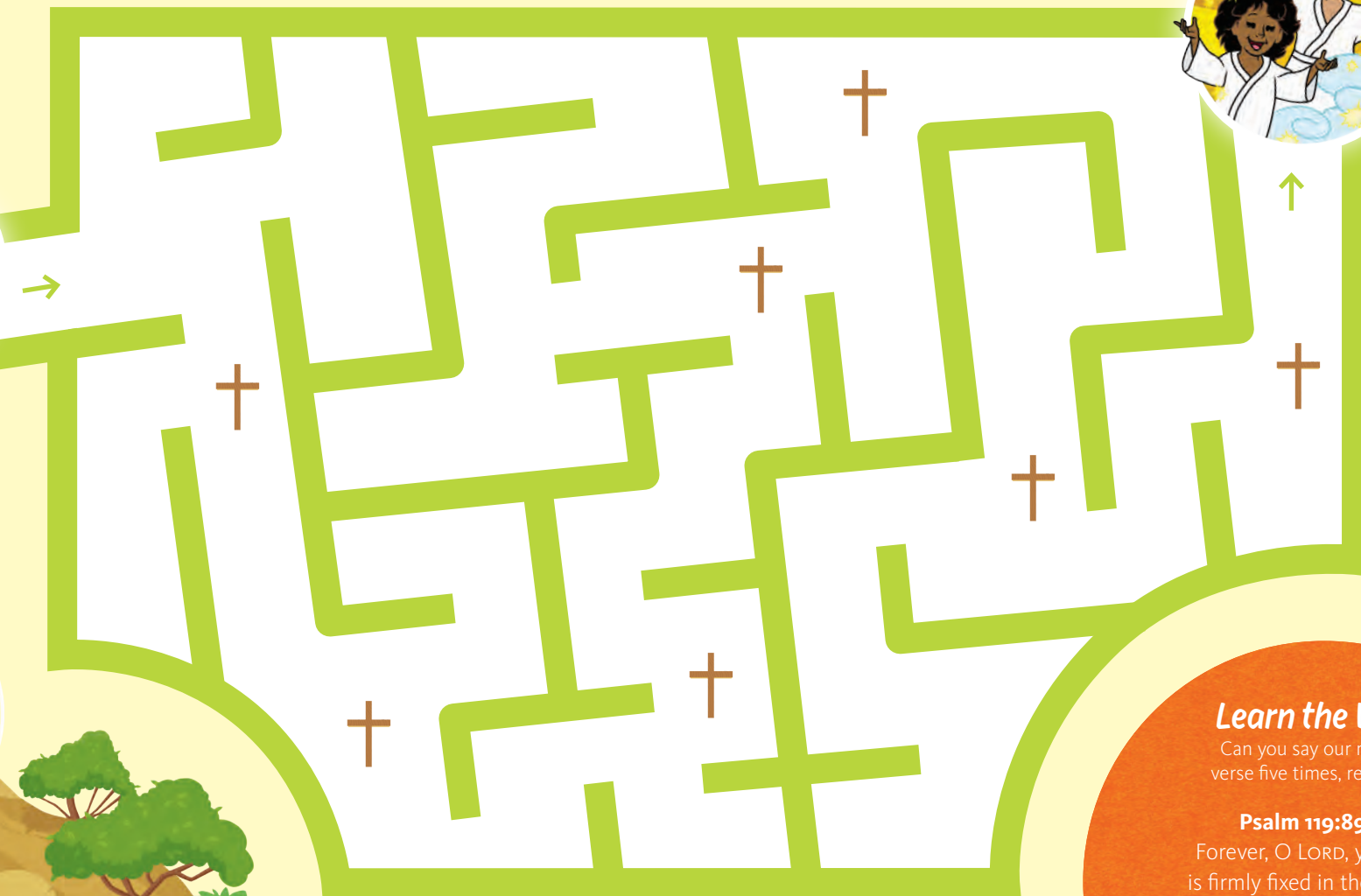
